

Create New GIS Image – From Scratch

Open EFS

Select from the menu **File → New Workspace**

When the *Load Base Map* dialogue box comes up, select **Cancel (A)**.



You will now be in a blank workspace.

Select from the menu **Workspace → Create New GIS Image**


The *Create GIS Image* dialogue box comes up.

This is where you will add the layers to go in your thumbnail.

Select the **Add GIS layers to workspace (B)**. Don't add more than a few layers because the thumbnail image is small. **Make sure all layers you want to see in the thumbnail have a MIN and MAX value set to 0 (otherwise the thumbnail won't work right at all)**. You can change this back later after thumbnail generated.




When the layers have been added then highlight them **(C)**, make sure the Coordinate System is correct (change if necessary) **(D)**.



Select your background Color **(E)**
Select your Initial GSD **(F)** (1,000 is good)
Select the name for the GIS Image **(G)**

Name your image **(H)** (goes under the thumbnail)
