**RE: ADDENDUM NUMBER TWO TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) FOR DIGITAL  
AERIAL DATA FOR LOS ANGELES REGION IMAGERY ACQUISITION CONSORTIUM  
(LAR-IAC) – LAR-IAC4 RFP**

This Addendum Number Two to the RFP is issued by the County of Los Angeles (County) through its Chief Information Office (CIO). A copy of this Addendum shall be e-mailed to each person or organization that attended the Mandatory Proposers' Conference on August 1, 2013, in addition to being posted on County's Open Bids and Solicitations portal at:

Unless defined in this Addendum, any term with initial letter capitalized shall have the meaning given to such term in the RFP.

This Addendum clarifies certain discrepancies within the RFP as follows:

1. Proposer's Organization Questionnaire/Affidavit and Required Support Documents for Corporations and Limited Liabilities (*Exhibit 1 to Appendix C*) should be included with the proposal as *Item Number 4*, consistent with *Section 2.10 (Business Proposal Format)* of the RFP, despite *Exhibit 1 to Appendix C* instructing to include it as the first page of proposals.
2. In each *Subsection e (Part E – Sample of Products)* under *Sections 2.10.6(1) – 2.10.6(2)* and elsewhere in the RFP, the phrase in parentheses "digital and/or hard copies" should be interpreted as "digital and, as necessary, hard copies", consistent with *Section B (Samples) of Appendix B (Statement of Work)* requiring that the samples be submitted in digital form (i.e., at a minimum). Proposers are to use judgment as to whether hard copies of samples are necessary to help the County evaluate the proposals.
3. The title of *Section 3.4* of the RFP should read as "Proposal Evaluation and Criteria" in lieu of "Business Proposal Evaluation and Criteria".
4. Pursuant to each *Subsection 6 (Proposer's Cost Proposal (25%))* under *Sections 3.4.1 – 3.4.4* and elsewhere in the RFP, the Local SBE Preference may be applied to the cost submitted by qualified Local SBE Proposers. The Local SBE Preference does not apply to subcontractors or anyone else not submitting a Cost Proposal to the County in response to the RFP.

All other terms and conditions of the RFP shall remain unchanged.
