Competition Rules

1. Must be a full-time student in high school, community college or a university (undergraduate only) in the United States.
2. The map must be the original work of the entrant.
3. "Bizarre" refers to maps that are strikingly out of the ordinary. All maps must use real-world data.
4. No imaginary, hand drawn or video game maps.
5. Submit map in a static PDF format (no interactive or animated maps) no larger than letter size.
6. A summary description is required.
7. Each student can only submit one entry. Map should be designed and created by one student only (no teamwork).

Cash Awards!!

- 1st place: \$5000 cash**
2nd place: \$1000 cash
3rd place: \$600 cash
4th - 10th place: \$200 cash each

Judging Procedures

Two rounds:

- 1: Five world-renowned cartographers select the TOP TEN entries.
- 2: Public voting

(Students selected to the TOP TEN will be asked to supply documents proving their full-time status.)
