Admission Requirements

- A baccalaureate (bachelor's) degree from an accredited college or university
- A grade-point average (GPA) of 2.75 or greater in the last 60 semester/90 quarter units attempted.* (The entire semester or quarter in which the 60/90 units began will be used in the calculation.)
- At least one year of professional GIST experience

* Postgraduate coursework is included in the calculation only if it consists of standard academic offerings at the upper-division level (third year/junior level or above). Nonstandard credit offerings (professional training, CEU courses, non-degree or other professional credits) are not included in the calculation.
