*Whereas* THERE IS A NEED TO PROMOTE GIS AWARENESS, EDUCATION, AND TRAINING AMONG VARIOUS GROUPS TO EFFECTIVELY UTILIZE THIS RAPIDLY DEVELOPING TECHNOLOGY; AND

*Whereas* THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY ENTERPRISE GIS STEERING COMMITTEE COORDINATES EFFORTS TO ELIMINATE DUPLICATION, REDUCE COSTS, DEVELOP STANDARDS, AND FACILITATE THE SHARING AND INTERCHANGE OF GIS DATA, METHODS, AND KNOWLEDGE:
