Pictometry for ArcGIS Desktop Version 10.0.3.3 Now Available

We are pleased to announce the release of Pictometry for ArcGIS Desktop Version 10.0.3.3.

Now available for immediate download, this new Release includes the following feature improvements:

The Display tab of the Settings dialog now contains options that let you enable or disable messages relating to adding images. You can enable or disable the following:

- A warning message that appears when you attempt to add an image and are close to your limit, and An error message that appears you attempt to add an image and the limit has been met.
- You now have the option of automatically synchronizing the map with the current image as you pan. This option is found on the Display tab of the Settings dialog.

Both the 32-bit and 64-bit installers are now single-part installations, eliminating the additional OCX installation process, which makes these products easier to install

This version includes an updated user guide.

The following bugs have been fixed:

- Previously, if the Pictometry for ArcGIS Desktop Extension and Pictometry for ArcGIS Desktop-NAV Extension were on a single machine, uninstalling one of the two would cause issues in the remaining extension. This issue has been corrected. To avoid this issue please update to the latest Pictometry for ArcGIS Desktop extension

Known issues

- Some complex polygons do not draw correctly when overlaid on Pictometry images.
- Some settings are not applied until the next image is loaded.
- Layers that are grouped are not overlaid on Pictometry images.
- Pictometry tools are not functional in Layout view. Switch to Data view to use the Pictometry tools.
- Some Windows 7 and Windows Vista users with restricted user privileges might not be able to use this extension. See your IT administrator for assistance.

If you want to use Windows Explorer (not Internet Explorer) to access the FTP site:

- Launch Windows Explorer
- Type or paste the following text into the Address bar at the top:

- Press ENTER and you will be logged in and see the folders containing the various ArcGIS Extensions.
- The folder named **Pictometry for ArcGIS Desktop 10.0.3.3** contains the new release installer.
