

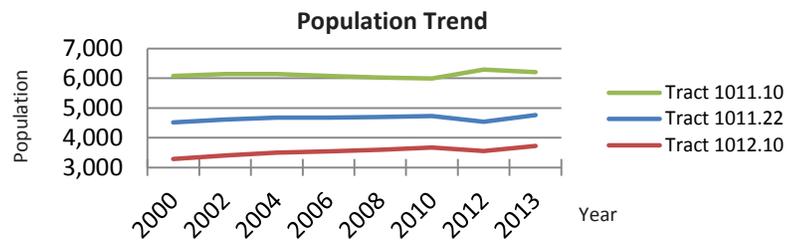
eGIS Demographic Data & Services



The eGIS Program acquires small area demographic estimates each year for use by eGIS members to support service delivery and planning by County departments.

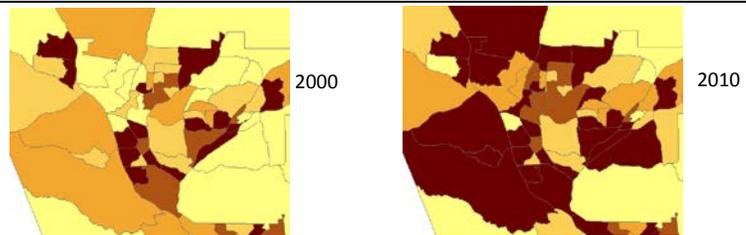
Population Trends

Find out how populations in your service areas are changing over time, so you can ensure your service delivery meets the needs of your clients.



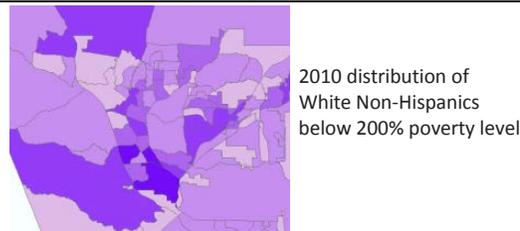
Population Estimates

Get estimates of the population every year to see how population growth is changing the face of the County.



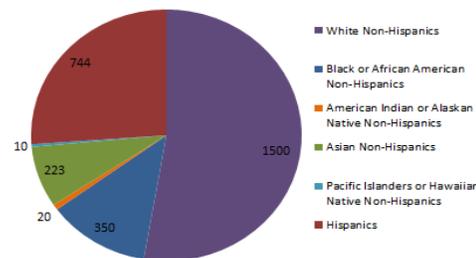
Poverty Distribution

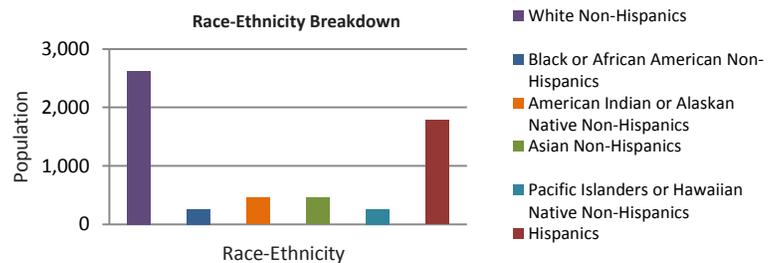
Race-Ethnicity Distribution

This information can help guide language and culture specific programs determine where concentrations of specific client populations are.



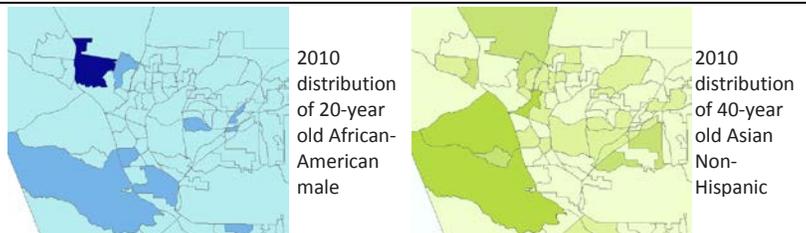
Race-Ethnicity Breakdown
