Most noteworthy, Devra launched SALUS, HSAC's crisis and event management platform, which makes powerful GIS tools available to first responders. She previously served as the Assistant Chief of Emergency Management and Administration at Loyola Marymount University and as an Emergency Management Coordinator at the City of Los Angeles Emergency Management Department. During her tenure with the City, Devra created the award-winning City of Los Angeles Emergency Management Internship Program.
